



Application for the 2026-2027 Greater Kaweah Groundwater Sustainability Agency (“GKGSA”) Land Fallowing Program

The Greater Kaweah Groundwater Sustainability Agency has established a Land Fallowing Program in order to immediately reduce groundwater extraction within GKGSA’s jurisdictional boundaries, reduce impacts to domestic and irrigation wells, and effectuate the objectives of GKGSA’s Groundwater Sustainability Plan and the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (“SGMA”).

The GKGSA Board is pleased to repeat the program again this year as it was successfully conducted last year. The program is set with a fixed price per acre providing predictability for participants. The program will involve the following:

Eligibility.

Any farmable land within GKGSA’s boundaries with four or more acres is eligible to apply. Applicants must be in good standing with the GKGSA and comply with all other rules, regulations, statutes, laws, etc.

Program Restrictions.

Cover crops are permitted under the Program but may only be irrigated by precipitation, and no harvesting of the crop is permitted. However, grazing is permitted.

Application Process.

GKGSA program’s process consists of determination of Program need, application submission, review and awarding of applicants, verification process, and payment after the year following.

GKGSA will announce the beginning and end dates in which applications will be accepted. The application submissions will be accepted on a first come first serve basis. Each will be reviewed, and applicants will be notified of acceptance or denial within time to plan for the upcoming year. Awardees will receive \$400.00 for each acre of Program land successfully fallowed for the year.

Award Payment.

Timing and Amount of Payments. Payments to those receiving awards will occur approximately fourteen (14) months following the start of the water year. Each party receiving an award will receive one (1) annual payment. The award recipient may elect to receive the award in December or January following the end of the contracted following period.
